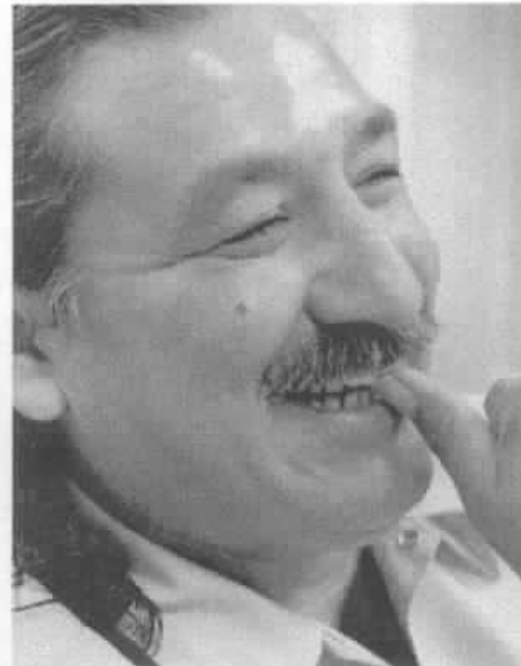

His name is Leonard Peltier. He is a 60 year old lifelong American Indian activist. He is a political prisoner of the United States government, sentenced to two life terms in prison for a crime he did not commit, the killing of two FBI agents at the Jumping Bull family ranch on the Pine Ridge Reservation, while defending the Lakota people against the depredations of government inspired vigilante death squads. He is a writer, an artist, a Nobel Peace Prize nominee and the nominee of the Peace and Freedom Party for President of the United States.

Leonard Peltier speaks:

I am a Native American. I have survived poverty, discrimination and genocidal policies. I want all people to have education, employment, housing and health care. We need equal rights, liberty and justice for all.

If elected, my top three priorities will be:

- Abolish the federal death penalty and release all political prisoners.
- Make the government abide by all its treaties with Native Americans and other nations.
- Remove all U.S. troops from other countries such as Iraq and Afghanistan.

Luther Standing Bear, a Sioux Chief, stated: “Out of the Indian approach to life came a great freedom, an intense and absorbing love for nature; a respect for life... and principals of truth, honesty, generosity, equity, and brotherhood as a guide to mundane relations.” These values will guide me as president.

I am a Native American, deprived of my language, culture, and traditions; yet, I have survived the genocidal government policies against Indigenous Peoples. I will ensure equal rights to liberty, education, employment, housing, and health care, regardless of race, ethnicity, gender, religion, or sexual orientation. I will work towards conflict resolution without the use of violence and ensure self-determination for all peoples.

I live with injustice every day. Caged for over 28 years for a crime I did not commit, I am a political prisoner wrongfully convicted by a government that indisputably withheld and fabricated evidence, as well as coerced witnesses. No branch of the government will correct this injustice. At the root of this injustice are the oppressive policies of the U.S. government against people of color and those with dissenting opinions. I pledge to eliminate such policies. I will abolish the federal death penalty and restore the constitutional protections which ensure justice for all people.

Our environment is the essence of our life, but our government, in partnership with greedy corporations, haphazardly destroys it for the monetary benefit of a few. I will protect our environment to ensure our survival and the survival of our future generations.

Vice Presidential Candidate Janice Jordan:

I am honored to be the Vice-Presidential candidate of the Peace and Freedom Party of California, the only socialist and feminist party with ballot status in the most populous state in the United States. I have lived in California all of my life, and been active from a very young age in social justice, human services and environmental issues.

The current situation of international violence and occupation could have been avoided through dialogue and diplomacy, traits that Leonard Peltier and I take pride in as social justice and human rights advocates. There is only one political party in power in the United States and unfortunately diplomacy, justice, civil rights and human rights take a backstage to unregulated military spending, unchecked human rights violations, police crime and money. The United States is not a leader in democracy or freedom; it has alienated itself from the rest of the world and from many of its own people.

Over the years, I have worked to end the disproportionate incarceration of poor people and people of color; the rise of homelessness among women, men, children and families (especially veterans); rampant military spending; police brutality; and the environmental destruction of reservations. I continue to fight for low-cost housing availability, livable wages, free speech, free health care, access to higher education, social security safety for seniors, same-sex marriage rights, and medical marijuana, in coalition with local and national grassroots groups and organizations. Government policies to benefit the working-class and working poor should be a priority not a problem. Jobs, healthcare, education and a livable wage are a right, not a privilege.

One or two people cannot cure the ills created over centuries of abuse and neglect. However, Leonard Peltier and I intend to listen to communities that have been overlooked and ignored, and to advocate that each person has the right to live a healthy, productive and safe life in the richest country in the world. Working for effective change can happen only at the risk of voting your conscience, not your fear.

Dump the Repugnocrats!

This may be the most important election campaign of our times. We are told our only choices are a reactionary zealot whose plans to expand the U.S. empire have already embroiled us in two wars and devastated our economy and a very intelligent reactionary who has openly stated his plans to expand on the zealot's wars, increase the military and continue a policy of pre-emptive war. In fact our only choice is to begin now to build an alternative to this madness. Peace and Freedom Party offers a clear analysis of the problems and alternative solutions that can work. Help build this Party for our children and our children's children, that they may breathe clean air and live in peace and dignity.
